PATTERN NOTES AND ABBREVIATIONS

- Sew with a ¼" seam allowance throughout, unless noted.
- For best fabric nesting results, follow pressing arrows shown in the pattern, unless otherwise stated.
- •Blocks or units may be assembled larger to allow for precise trimming throughout.
- Abbreviations to note:

RST - Right Sides Together

HST - Half Square Triangle(s)

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

1. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of all Fabric A squares.

With RST, pair Fabric A squares with Fabric C squares. Sew a ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line. Trim on the drawn line.

Open the HST and press towards Farbic C. Trim all the HST to 2 ½" x 2 ½" (4 ½" x 4 ½").









2. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of all (8) Fabric G squares.

With RST, place (4) Fabric G squares on the top left corner of all Fabric B rectangles as shown.

Sew on the drawn line.

Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line.

Press according to the arrows.











3. With RST, place remaining Fabric G squares on the top right corner of the unit as shown.

Sew on the drawn line.

Trim a ¼" away from the sewn line.

Press according to the arrows.

The unit should measure 3 %" x 2 ¼" (6 ¼" x 4").







Make 4

4. Using (4) Fabric E and (4) Fabric F rectangles, assemble the corner units as shown.

Press as desired.

The unit should measure 3 %" x 3 %" (6 ¼" x 6 ¼").

5. Assemble the block as shown using the remaining Fabric D square.

Pay attention to the rotation of the units.


Press as desired.

Block should measure 8" x 8" (15 ½" x 15 ½").




