PATTERN NOTES AND ABBREVIATIONS

• Sew with a ¼" seam allowance throughout, unless noted.

- For best fabric nesting results, follow pressing arrows shown in the pattern, unless otherwise stated.
- •Blocks or units may be assembled larger to allow for precise trimming throughout.
- Abbreviations to note:
 - RST Right Sides Together HST - Half Square Triangle(s)


BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

1. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of (8) Fabric D squares.

With RST, using (2) Fabric D squares, place one on the top left and one on the bottom right corners of (2) Fabric A squares.

Sew a ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line. Trim on the drawn line.

Press according to the arrows.




2. With WST, place the remaining (4) Fabric D squares at the bottom left corners of the (4) half flying geese units as shown.

Sew a ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line. Trim on the drawn line.

Press according to the arrows.

The (8) Flying Geese units should measure 1 ³⁄₄" x 3" (3" x 5 ¹⁄₂").




3. Sew together (2) flying geese units made in steps 1 and 2.

Press as desired.

The unit should measure 1 ³/₄" x 5 ¹/₂" (3" x 10 ¹/₂").




4. Repeat steps 1 and 2 with the remaining (8) Fabric A and (2) Fabric D squares. The (8) Flying Geese units should measure 1 ³⁄₄" x 3" (3" x 5 ¹⁄₂").






5. Using (4) A/F flying geese made in step 3, (4) Fabric B and (1) Fabric C squares. sew together the center star unit as shown. Press as desire.

The unit should measure 5 ½" x 5 ½" (10 ½" x 10½").



6. Using the remianing (4) Fabric E squares, assemble the block as shown. Pay attention to the rotation of the units. Press as desired.

Block should measure 8" x 8" (15 ½" x 15 ½").



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
