## PATTERN NOTES AND ABBREVIATIONS

- Sew with a ¼" seam allowance throughout, unless noted.
- For best fabric nesting results, follow pressing arrows shown in the pattern, unless otherwise stated.
- •Blocks or units may be assembled larger to allow for precise trimming throughout.
- Abbreviations to note:

RST - Right Sides Together

HST - Half Square Triangle(s)

#### **BLOCK CONSTRUCTION**

1. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of all Fabric A squares.

With RST, pair all Fabric A squares with all Fabric D squares.

Sew a ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line. Trim on the drawn line.

Open the HST and press open.

Trim all the HST to 2" x 2" (3 ½" x 3 ½").









2. Using (8) Fabric H squares and the (8) HST made in step one, sew together corner unit as shown. Press open.

The units should measure 3 ½" x 3 ½" (6 ½" x 6 ½").

3. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of all Fabric C and F squares.

With RST, place (4) Fabric C squares on the bottom left and (4) Fabric F squares on the top right of (4) Fabric G squares as shown.

Sew on the drawn line. Trim a ¼" away from the sewn line.

Press according to the arrows.











With RST, place the remaining (4) Fabric C squares on the bottom right and (4) Fabric F squares on the top left of the unit as shown.

Press according to the arrows.

The units should measure 2" x 2" (3 ½" x 3 ½").

4. Using (4) Fabric E and (4) Fabric B rectangles, sew together the center units as shown.

Press according to the arrows.

The unit should measure 2" x 3 ½" (3 ½" x 6 ½").








5. Using the remaing (1) Fabric H square, assemble the block as shown.


Pay attention to the rotation of the units. Press as desired.

Block should measure 8" x 8" (15  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15  $\frac{1}{2}$ ").
