



## 2026 SAWTOOTH SAMPLER - BLOCK OF THE MONTH

### Fabric Requirements and Setting Instructions

Finished Quilt Size 69 ½" x 69 ½"

#### PATTERN NOTES, ABBREVIATIONS AND BOM INFORMATION

- Sew with a ¼" seam allowance throughout, unless noted.
- For best fabric nesting results, follow pressing arrows shown in the pattern, unless otherwise stated.
- Blocks or units may be assembled larger to allow for precise trimming throughout.
- The use of directional fabric may alter the yardage requirements.
- Abbreviations to note:
  - RST - Right Sides Together
  - HST - Half Square Triangle(s)
  - WOF - Width of Fabric, 42" - 44"
  - HWOFF - Half Width of Fabric, 21" - 22"
  - LOF - Length of Fabric
- Two center blocks will be released each month and will measure 6" x 6" finished.
- All blocks are traditionally pieced without the use foundation paper, templates or speciality rulers.
- Blocks will be released the 3rd Tuesday of each month.

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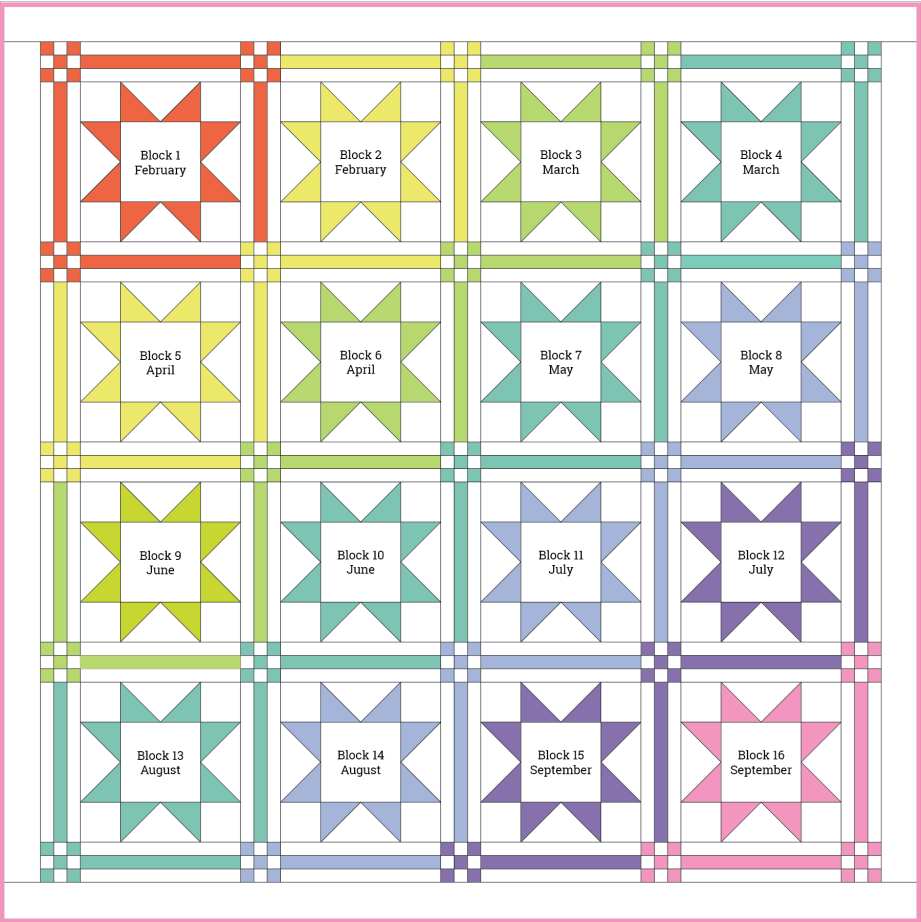

Binding	¾ yard
Backing	2 ¼ yards of 108" or 4 ½ yards for a seamed back

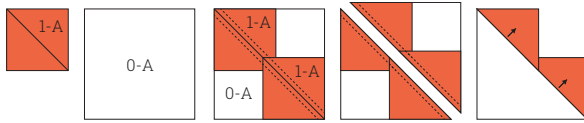

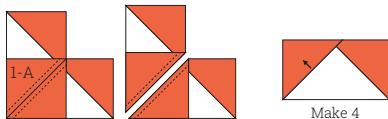



## SAWTOOTH STAR SAMPLER SETTING INSTRUCTIONS

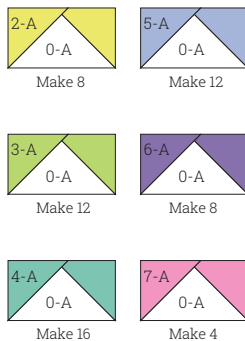
1. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of all (4) Fabric 1-A squares.  
With RST, place (1) Fabric 1-A squares on the top left and (1) on the bottom right corner of (1) Fabric 0-A square.  
Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the drawn line.  
Trim on the drawn line.  
Press according to the arrows.



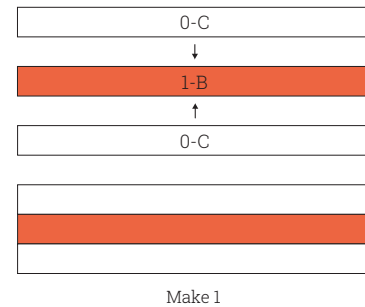
- With RST, place the remaining (2) Fabric 1-A squares at the bottom left corners of the (2) units as shown.  
Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the drawn line.  
Trim on the drawn line.  
Press according to the arrows.  
The flying geese units should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



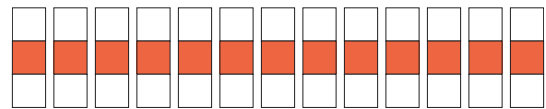
Repeat this step using the all the remaining Fabric 0-A and Fabric 2-A thru 7-A squares.



2. Using (1) Fabric 1-B and (2) Fabric 0-C rectangles, sew together the strip unit as shown.  
Press according to the arrows.  
The strip unit should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x HWOFF.

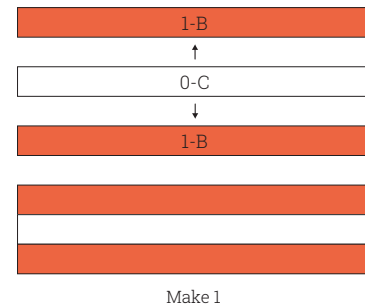


Subcut the strip unit into  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " units.

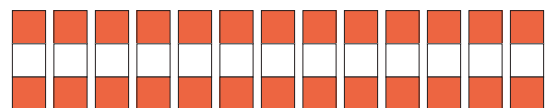


Repeat using (1) Fabric 2-B thru 7-B and (2) Fabric 0-C rectangles as shown.

3. Using (2) Fabric 1-B and (1) Fabric 0-C rectangles, sew together the strip unit as shown.  
Press according to the arrows.  
The strip unit should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x HWOFF.



Subcut the strip unit into  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " units.

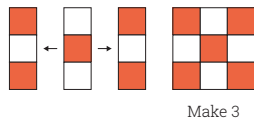


Repeat using (2) Fabric 2-B thru 7-B and (1) Fabric 0-C rectangles as shown.

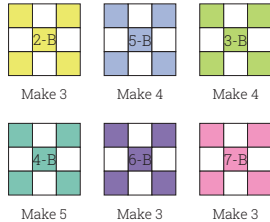


## SAWTOOTH STAR SAMPLER SETTING INSTRUCTIONS

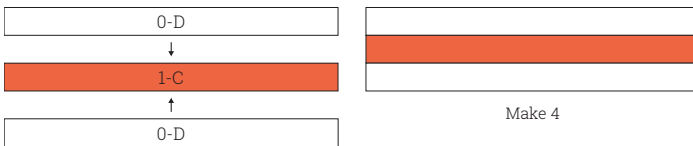
4. Using the subcut units from steps two and three, sew together the nine patch units as shown. Press according to the arrows. The units should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ .



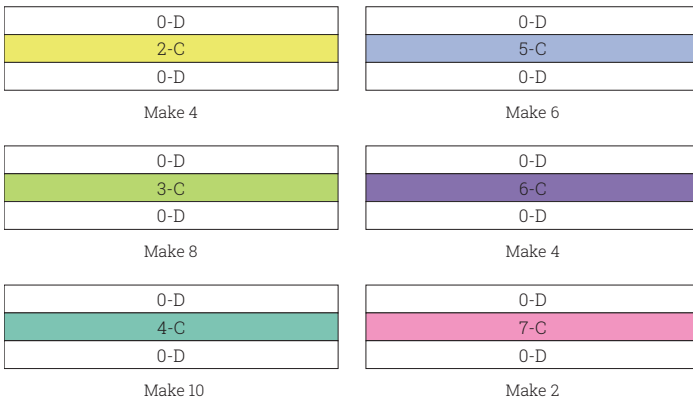
Repeat for Fabrics 2 thru 7 as shown.  
*\*You will not use all the subcut pieces.*



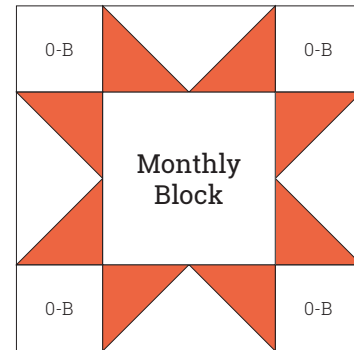
5. Using (2) Fabric 0-D and (1) Fabric 1-C, sew together the sashing unit as shown. Press according to the arrows. The sashing units should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ .



Repeat with the remaining Fabric 0-D and Fabric 2 thru 7-C rectangles.



6. (4) Fabric 0-B squares, (4) flying geese units from step one and each monthly block are used for the Sawtooth Star Block setting. Press as desired. Each block should measure  $12\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ .



7. Once all blocks are complete, use the quilt image to guide layout placement using the 9-patch blocks and sashing units made in steps four and five. Press as desired. The quilt top, without borders, should measure  $63\frac{1}{2}" \times 63\frac{1}{2}"$ .

8. Sew together (8) border strips end to end. Subcut into the following lengths:  
 (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 63\frac{1}{2}"$  for left and right borders  
 (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 69\frac{1}{2}"$  for top and bottom borders  
 Sew on left and right borders first, followed by the top and the bottom borders.  
 Press seams towards the borders.  
 The quilt top, with borders, should measure  $69\frac{1}{2}" \times 69\frac{1}{2}"$ .

9. Prepare backing for quilting using preferred method.  
 10. With RST, sew together (8) binding strips end to end using preferred binding construction method.  
 11. Quilt and bind as desired.
