QUILTING PRICES

Quilt Top Size (Height x Width) in inches will give you the quilt top's square inches
Quilting starts at \$0.023 per square inch and increases based off the design and size.

There is a minimum quilting charge of \$40.00

Minimum backing fabric requirement no met	\$30.00

Machine binding to front of quilt only	\$0.10 per perimeter inch
Machine binding to front and back of quilt	\$0.20 per perimeter inch
Machine binding to front and hand binding to back of quilt	\$0.30 per perimeter inch
Quilts larger than 8500 square inches	\$25.00 additional fee

All sales will include a 6.75% sales tax.
Customers are responsible for all shipping cost

BATTING

Quilter's Dream Batting is available for purchase by the inch, if needed.
Batting is 93" wide or by the package.

100% Cotton - White	\$0.60 per inch
80/20 Blend - White	\$0.50 per inch
King White Cotton 122" x 120"	\$76.00 per package
King White 80/20 Blend 122" x 120"	\$69.00 per package

Speciality batting can be ordered if needed, but this may increase the turn around time.

Due to availability, batting from The Warm Company may be used in place of Quilter's Dream if it is unavailable.

quilt preparation

QUILT TOP

- Ensuring that you have prepared your quilt top for long arm quilting helps to make the process smoother.
- Your quilt top should be as square as possible. Uneven tops and borders can result in puckers and wavy quilting.
- Give your top a good haircut. Clip all loose and excess threads from the back. Dark threads will show.
- Measure your top's height and width in inches.
- Give your top an all over press, paying attention that bulky seams are as flat as possible.
- If your quilt is directional, safety pin a note to indicate the top of the quilt.

BACKINGS

- In order to load the quilt onto the frame for quilting, your back must be at least 5 inches larger than your top side on all four sides. For example: If your top is 60" x 80" your backing should be 70" x 90".
- Backings smaller than requested may not be quilted or a charge may be added for the additional steps it will take to load it on to the frame.
- Backing should be squared up. Uneven backings will not load properly onto the frame. This could result in distortion of the quilt and will require additional prep work to ensure this does not occur.
- Seamed backings should be done horizontally if possible to decrease bulk on the frame. Quilts with a vertically seamed backing will be loaded horizontally and this may effect your desired quilting design.
- Give your backing a good press and trim.
- If your backing is directional, safety pin a note to indicate the top of the backing.

EDGE TO EDGE PANTOGRAPHS, THREAD AND BATTING

- At this time I only offer Edge to Edge Quilting.
- If you chose to have a novelty themed design quilted that must be purchased, there will be a 50% of the cost charge.
- Matching Glide thread is used on the top and bottom of the quilt. There is no charge for standard thread and needle. This is included in the minimum quilting charge.
- I offer a variety of Quilter's Dream batting at a cost, or you may choose to provide your own batting.
- Due to availability, batting from The Warm Company may be used in place of Quilter's Dream if it is unavailable.
- Batting should be at least 3-4 inches larger than your quilt top on all four sides.

GENERAL DISCLOSURES

- Photography of your project may be done for promotional purposes. These photos may be used on social media platforms or used on alywilsonquilts.com. Credit will be given to the customer for the construction of the quilt top, pattern and fabric designers.
- Credit to Aly Wilson Quilts should be given for the quilting in customer's photography and quilt show displays.
- Quilting puckers and waves due to uneven quilt tops, borders, or backings will not result in a refund of money.
- Aly Wilson Quilts is a pet friendly home based business. The quilting area is kept pet free and cleaned frequently.
- Quilts unclaimed/unpaid for 3 months after completion and after multiple, unsuccessful communication attempts will be considered "Abandoned Quilts". These quilts will either be donated or sold.
- There is a minimum quilting charge of \$40.00. This does not include batting and other charges that may occur.
- Trimming and binding may be offered on a case by case basis. Cuddle backings will not be trimmed.
- If you are planning to self bind your quilt with it's backing, please let me know ahead of time, since the edge to edge quilting will extend the top surface.
- Currently completion time is updated on my website. Quilts needing to be completed quicker than the posted time will be charged a "move to the front of the line" fee.
- Payment is accepted via Cash, Check, Zelle, Venmo or PayPal.
- Due to manufacturing delays and shipping that are out of my control, if Quilter's Dream Batting is unavailable, batting from the Warm Company will be substituted as it is of equal quality.

SHIPPING TO AND FROM ALY WILSON QUILTS

- Prior to shipping your quilt to me, make sure that you have received email/text confirmation that I am able to accommodate your needs and I am ready for your quilt.
- Customers are financially responsible for the shipping to and from Aly Wilson Quilts.
- Return shipping options will be given to you, so that you may select your preference and options.
- Invoices must be paid in full prior to shipping/return of your quilt.
